## Making a Difference October 22, 2016

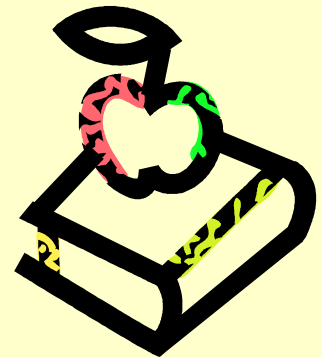
